

## ARE JUDGES ABOVE THE LAW?

There is a very important civil rights Petition before the Supreme Court that needs our support.

Title 18 U. S. C. § 242 holds corrupt judges accountable for criminal behavior in the courtroom. Ordinary citizens are the typical victims of such crimes. Unfortunately, the only way for a private citizen to enjoy protection under this law is to ask another (unsympathetic) judge for permission to bring charges. Being motivated by “preservation of the species,” that permission is *always* denied.

Title 18 U.S.C. § 3332 provides ordinary citizens the right to bring evidence of criminal judicial misbehavior **directly** to a grand jury **without** being filtered through another judge. For similar reasons, permission to use this law is also *always* denied. These laws therefore, are effectively meaningless.

Did Congress intend that the subjects of inquiry (bad judges) be the gatekeepers of inquiry?

If this conflict of interest is resolved, it will force a whole new era of fairness in our courts. No longer will judges be able to wrongfully separate citizens from their property, their liberty or their lives. Corrupt judges will be held accountable and the people will be better served.

Everyone’s civil rights are at issue...especially those of the weak and the poor. We need to create national awareness and support for this Petition and we need to do it before August 2006.
